REVIEW & USE 1 Corinthians

REVIEW:

- A life of love, not theological knowledge, identifies us with God. (1 Cor. 8:2-3)
- Flaunted freedom harms those for whom Christ died (1 Cor. 8:9-10)
- "Stumbling" one of God's beloved children should be unthinkable (1 Cor. 8:13)
- A Love-driven Perspective Surrenders Personal Freedoms for Others (1 Cor 9:12b-17)

<u>SUMMARY</u>: Love (for God and others) motivates the use (or non-use) of our freedoms. Paul establishes himself as a model of this love.

THREE DAILY REMINDERS ABOUT AGAPE-LOVE...

1) THE GREATEST USE OF _____ IS AGAPE-LOVE.

<u>1Co 13:13 NLT</u> " ... faith, hope, and love--and the greatest of these is love."

1Co 14:1 ESV "Pursue love..."

<u>1Ti 1:5 ESV "</u>The aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith."

a) Agape-Love brings the deepest meaning to life.

<u>Mat 22:37-40 NLT</u> "Jesus replied, "...love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' 38 This is the first and **greatest commandment.** 39 A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 <u>The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."</u>

<u>1Co 13:1-3 NIV</u> "If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, **but do not have love, I am only** a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. 2 If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, **but do not have love, I am nothing.** 3 If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, **but do not have love, I gain nothing.**"

<u>1Co 13:13 NLT</u> "Three things will last forever--faith, hope, and <u>love</u>--**and the greatest of** these is love."

b) Agape-Love is the conduit that helps people see & value Jesus.

<u>John 13:34-35 ESV</u> "A new commandment I give to you, that you **love one another**: just **as I have loved you**, you also are to **love one another**. 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, **if you have love** for one another."

c) Agape-Love is eternal.

Lam 3:22-23 ESV "The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases;"

1Co 13:13 NLT "Three things will last forever--faith, hope, and love ... "

1Jn 3:18 NLT "... let's not merely say that we love each other; **let us show the truth by our** actions."

Eph 5:1-2 *NIV* "<u>Follow God's example</u>, therefore, as dearly loved children 2 and **walk in the way of love**, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God."

3) THE GREATEST TIME TO AGAPE-LOVE IS _____.

Pro 3:27-28 NLT "**Do not withhold** good from those who deserve it when it's in your power to help them **[now]**. 28 If you can help your neighbor now, **don't say**, "Come back tomorrow, and then I'll help you.""

Gal 6:10 ESV "... as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith."

Eph 5:15-16 NIV "Be very careful, then, how you live--not as unwise but as wise, 16 making the most of every opportunity..."
