## MESSAGE NOTES

Titus 1:1-5

## Setting the Stage: Historical Background

- 1. The Apostle Paul and his young partner, Titus, were serving together on the island of Crete as church planters.
- 2. Paul had to leave Crete, but left Titus there to complete the work.
- 3. Paul then wrote Titus a brief letter providing him with instructions for setting the churches of Crete in line with God's plan for local church governance.

#### An Invaluable Introduction

Paul identifies himself, greets his audience, and gives his reason for writing. (1:1-5)

1. Paul: Humble missionary... (1a)

**Titus 1:1a** Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ,

a. ...tasked with teaching God's people lifestyle obedience to Jesus. (1b)

**Titus 1:1b** for the sake of the faith of God's elect and their knowledge of the truth, which accords with godliness,

b. ...fulfilling his calling confidently under God's faithfulness. (2-3)

**Titus 1:2** in hope of eternal life, which God, who never lies, promised before the ages began <sup>3</sup> and at the proper time manifested in his word through the preaching with which I have been entrusted by the command of God our Savior;



- 2. Titus: Paul's young apprentice and successor. (4)
  - **Titus 1:4** To Titus, my true child in a common faith: Grace and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Savior.
- 3. Paul's Intent: To direct Titus in correctly ordering the newly planted churches in Crete. (5)
  - **Titus 1:5** This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what remained into order, and appoint elders in every town as I directed you—

#### Why did Paul care about church order?

#### God appointed Paul to reveal His design for the local church.

**Eph. 3:8** To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, <sup>9</sup> and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God, who created all things, <sup>10</sup> so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. <sup>11</sup> This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord,

#### **An Overview of Core Themes**

Main Thrust: Orderly church life promotes godly living.

- 1. **Pastoral Integrity:** Qualifications for and responsibilities of church leadership, especially in regard to teaching (1:5-9; 2:1, 7, 15; 3:1-2, 8-11, 14)
- 2. **Pernicious Influence:** Destructive nature of false teaching, and the fitting response from leadership (1:9-16; 3:10-11)
- 3. **Personal Outcomes:** Link between content of teaching and the effects it has upon the hearers:
  - a. Sound Doctrine -> Godliness (1:1, 5-9; 2:1-14; 3:1-8, 14)
  - b. False Teaching -> Chaos & spiritual stagnation (1:10-11; 3:9)

- 1. Read or listen to Titus all the way through once per week as if you were Titus himself, working to understand Paul's words to you.
- 2. Jot down any new observations you make and compare them to what is taught during the Titus series.
- 3. Engage with the teaching team as you discover new insights, different understandings, and experience personal growth.
